
Installing the Pole and the Desk Clamp Assembly



Insert the pole (B) into the desk clamp (C) and tighten the screws using 3mm Allen Key (P-A). To adjust monitor height, first loosen collar screws using 3mm Allen Key (P-A), then set the collar at a desired position and tighten the collar screws using 3mm Allen Key (P-A).

Edge Installation




NOTE: Min. desktop thickness=10mm(0.39")
Max. desktop thickness=90mm(3.54")


- Determine the mounting location based on the display size, height adjustment and pitch/roll requirements
- Place the desk mount over the edge of the desk so that the clamp fully contacts the desk edge.
- Turn the knob to make clamp fit to the desk edge, then secure it tightly.

Grommet Installation



Reinstall the base plate with the three retained screws, and then tighten securely using a 4mm Allen Key (P-B). Then attach silicone pad for each screw.




Insert the adjust screw into the base plate through the hole and pad (P-F) as shown above. Then tighten the adjust screw to hold the mount securely.


NOTE: Min. hole diameter =10mm(0.39")
Max. hole diameter =70mm(2.76")

Installing the Adapter Bracket





Choose appropriate screws and washers according to the type of your display, and then attach the adapter bracket assembly onto the back of the display, and tighten the screws using a Philips screwdriver.




Tighten all screws but do not over tighten.

Tension Adjustment




To change the factory preset tension, first apply the force with the forearm and make sure that the arm is level, then using a 6mm Allen Key (P-D), slightly loosen or tighten the adjustment screw as necessary.

If display settles on its own, then rotate the adjustment screw towards the "+" symbol. If display rises on its own, then rotate the adjustment screw towards the "-" symbol.



Cable Management



NOTE: Leave slack in the cable for arm movement.
