






Fig. 1 - Power Derating Curve




Fig. 2 - Load Dump Power Characteristics (10 ms Exponential Waveform)








Fig. 3 - Pulse Waveform




Fig. 4 - Reverse Power Capability




Fig. 5 - Typical Instantaneous Forward Characteristics




Fig. 6 - Typical Reverse Characteristics

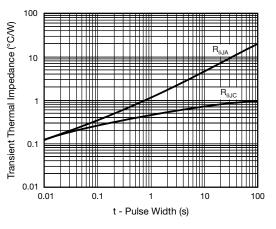


Fig. 7 - Typical Transient Thermal Impedance

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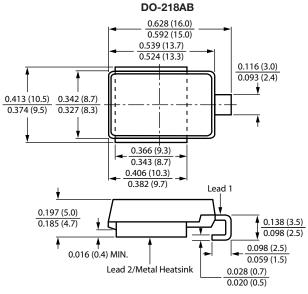
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
